

H2Koi

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Materials Used

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Yupo Paper or Craft Plastic
Rubbing Alcohol in Bottle w/ Fine Tip
Felt Applicator
Altenew Calming Koi Stamp & Die Set
Fresh Dye Inks: Jet Black
Caramel Toffee & Honey Drizzle
Ocean Waves & Sea Glass Alcohol Ink
Parchment & Neenah Cover Stock
Angled Detail Brush, Glue & Tape
Optional: Sentiment Die



Make a Splash

1. Use Yupo or Craft Plastic cut to 4 x 5.25 (A2 Card Front)
2. Put a few drops of each alcohol ink color on felt applicator.
3. Add a few Rubbing Alcohol drops.
4. Place applicator down in the center and press firmly.
5. Move in a circular motion, moving out like a spiral to the edges.
6. Repeat steps to create movement and layer color.
7. Overlap pouncing in varying degrees of pressure at the edges.
8. Decrease and lighten pouncing as you near the center.
9. Add depth by repeating steps using ink only and light pressure.
10. Create sea foam by adding rubbing alcohol and pounce lightly.



Go Fish

1. Use die set to cut fish bodies from cover stock.
2. Use parchment for fish fin pieces.
3. Use detail brush to color splotch the white fish pieces.
4. Use Koi stamps and fresh dye inks to create patterns on bodies.
5. Glue fish pieces together.
6. Cut sentiment from white paper.
7. Glue sentiment and fish to card base.
